### Tue Tue

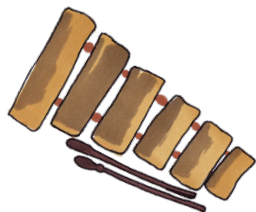
Tue tue, barima tue tue,

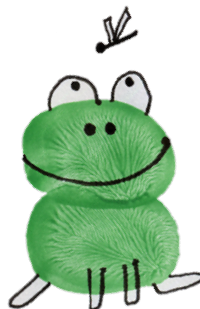
Still now and hear my singing, sweetly,

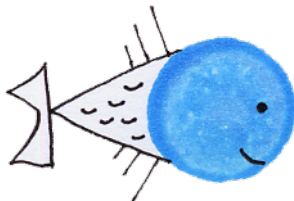
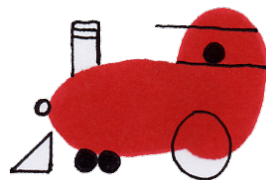
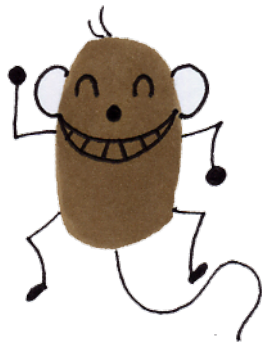
Pease porridge hot, pease porridge cold,

**How Do You Do Today?**

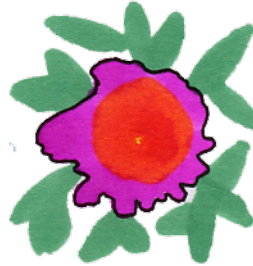
How do you do to- How do you do today?
